Block of the Month May Sunshine pinwheel and tree

Welcome to the Block of the Month for April. With this block, we are halfway to completing the mystery quilt. If you haven't started yet, this is a fun block to get you going. Happy sewing, Roxy



Fabric needed for sunshine:

Color 1: four 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares.

Color 2 (pinwheel): four 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares.

Background: one 4 ½" x 2" rectangle.

Fold the pinwheel (color 2) squares in half diagonally and iron.

Lay the folded triangle on top of the color 1 fabric, raw edges together. The folded side will be diagonal on the color 1 square.

Taking one point on the triangle, fold it down and pin it in place.

Repeat with the other 3 squares. Pay attention to which point you fold down. You want to make sure all are going the same way or your pinwheels won't spin.



Lay the block out and sew together to form a four patch. The center seam will be bulky so twirl the back seams and iron flat.

Sew a background strip 4 ½"x 2" to the top.



Fabric Needed for small tree.

One $4 \frac{1}{2}$ x 5" green for top of tree; one $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " brown for trunk.

Background: Four 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares to snowball corners, two 2" x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips for sides of trunk and one 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle.

Snowball the corners of the green tree top, trim and press back.

Sew a background strip to the left & right of the tree trunk.

Sew the trunk to the tree top.

Sew a background strip 4 ½" x 6 ½" to the top of the tree section.



Line up the sunshine and tree vertically and sew together. This block should measure 4 ½" x 20 ½",

Please join us for Annette Plog's fun lecture on the Care and Feeding of a Fabric Stash. Annette is a published author and nationwide teacher who will bring lots of tips and tricks to us. Most of us (surely I'm not the only one!) have more than a lifetime of fabric but somehow still finds the need or urge



to grow it. I don't think I have ever done a project with every piece of fabric out of my stash. There's always that one color or blender that I don't have. Come learn from Annette about this and lots more.

A workshop will be held on Wednesday with Annette at the Fabric Fanatic workroom. She will be teaching Curved Machine Piecing using a Jen Kingwell technique using templates. Currently the workshop is full. If you are interested in getting on the waiting list please see MJ.


